# TUSTUMENA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

Listed below are the basic supplies your child will need to begin the school year. There may be other items the teachers will request at a later date. Please check with your child so supplies can be replaced as needed.

#### KINDERGARTEN/FIRST GRADE

I backpack or bag

1 box markers

2 folders

l glue bottle (Elmer's)

1 set computer headphones

I pair, scissors, Fiskurs only, please

8 large glue sticks

24 pencils

I pair tennis shoes, to be left at school

(no black soles, Velcro or slip-on if they don't know how to tie shoes)

1 box crayons (24)

1 large box Kleenex

I spiral bound notebook, wide-ruled

I box colored pencils

Please put your child's name on all items.

# SECOND/THIRD GRADE

I backpack or bag

I set of headphones for computer (labeled winame)

I pair of Finker sensors

10 large white glue sticks

I bottle of Elmer's white glue, 4 oz.

48 pencils #2 standard

1 box crayons (48 or larger)

I set of colored pencils

2 large boxes of Kleenex

2 pkgs. Pink Pearl erasers

2 pkgs. pencil-top erasers

4 side-spiral notebooks, wide ruled, 70 sheet (3rd grade only)

1 pkg. notebook refill paper, unde ruled (3rd grade only)

2 hardbound, composition notebooks (2nd grade only)

1 box of freezer Ziploc baggies

I pair tennis shoes (labeled with name)

#### FOURTH, FIFTH, AND SIXTH GRADE

l backpack or bag

2 doz. #2 pencils

4 give sticks

I eraser, pink pearl

I pair. Fisker seissors

I set colored pencils (for 4th grade only)

1 ruler (both inches & centimeters)

2 large box Kleenex

I pair tennis shoes

100 lined 3 x 5 cards (for 5th & 6th Grade only)

4 Folders with pockets on both sides

4 spiral notebooks, 70 sheet composition, wide ruled (for 5th & 6th Grade only)

2 ink pens (1 red and 1 erasable)

2 pkgs. notebook filler paper, 200 sheets, wide ruled

2 pencil sharpeners (small)

1 set ear bud headphones
