

Tustumena Site Council Minutes

Meeting called to order at 4:02 p.m.

Minutes from 09/25/17 were reviewed. Minutes were amended to add Megan Roy in attendance. Doug Hayman motioned to approve minutes as amended. Megan Roy seconded. Amended minutes were unanimously approved. Minutes were not taken at the October meeting as it was the KPBSD Budget Presentation.

Old Business

Reader Board – Off site advertisements are not allowed on reader boards, therefore; we are not permitted to sell advertisements on a reader board to raise funds. Public service announcements are permitted. Site council discussed whether to pursue this project. A sign for the school has been discussed for at least eight years. Mr. Hayman agreed to put out a survey in the newsletter to gauge the level of support of parents, as well as to talk to the PTO. We will also inquire as to whether the district has a form letter for soliciting donations from businesses. Approximately \$30,000 would be needed to purchase and install.

Fall Carnival –The carnival had the highest estimated attendance to date and was the most profitable.

Garden Update- Shonia has left messages for the worm compost donation. We can begin to harvest some willow starts this year.

KPBSD Budget- Superintendent Dusek's video presentation and documents are still available on the KPBSD website. Early notification of funding is a top priority.

New Business

Turkey Bingo and Cash Raffle – Turkey bingo was the most profitable yet and was well attended. All tickets were sold for cash raffle. Drawing to be held December 8th.

Principal's Report –

Education Elements is coming to Tustumena to work with staff on Personalized Learning. Tustumena is a Wave 2 school. The focus is to create learning opportunities based on student need. Teachers from Sterling, Hope, Cooper Landing and Moose Pass will also be joining. Education Elements will interview and observe teachers to help determine next steps. The goal is to train students for their future in the age of innovation. Tustumena is currently working on teaching teamwork through the use of character autopsies.
